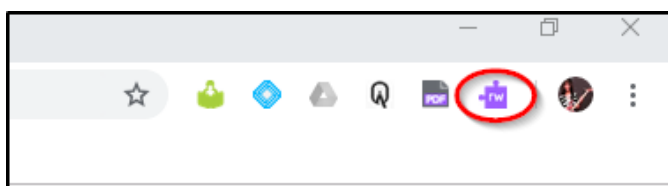
Dear Parents,


Ascension Public Schools provides a digital accessibility literacy support called [Read&Write for Google Chrome](#), a toolbar with over 20 tools that helps students read, write, and study independently.
